Overland – They have a range of nice products but I specifically love the texture on the Granito semi polished. The code was YISM 7104.

Nabel – Large format slab manufacture in China that may be a price option for some.

Gani Marble Tile – Check out the table in this booth. They always done a nice job with marbleized looking product but hey had a unique a table at 12 mm thick that is through body with the vein running through.

Estima – This Russian factory continues to improve its looks specifically with their new marble look called Ideal.

Kutahya – This is a Turkish company that had some nice looks but very competitive on the 2 cm pricing for east coast customers. One product I did like was called City. The lead gray was very nice.

Spazio – The anthracite grey is awesome with the blue color worked in. There is only two colors in this line but you don't need anymore.

Kera Tile – Luxent grey/white/black, loved it.

Kajaria – Indian company is still coming after the United States working through varies agents but are going to be opening an office in Pompano Beach Florida soon. Should be interesting to see how they make an impact.

Revoir Paris – Lots of encaustic patterns but some of the colors just don't work and doing large format on this look doesn't work with the grout joints.

Cerdomus – **Flame** 8"x48" wood. Beautiful wide range of colors. I liked the stripe deck 8x48.

Shine – 8"x48" and 5"x48" wood look very nice in a pallet, but I loved the mixture of the sizes.

Supreme/Supreme Modulo – Very nice range of marble colors in both polish and in a rustic pattern Versailles patterns.

Walls and more/Keradon – Very interesting ledger panels. I particularly liked 3"x15" Samurai.

Dream Tile – This company always had a nice range of wall tiles. Arvex beautiful range of mosaics. Don't be fooled by the LVT on the booth.

Italgres -Shale – Slate/ rustic, 5 colors, looks very nice.

Icone Bleu – Very interesting line but check out the floor Spazzlato finish. It's awesome.

Fiandre – panels what can I can they just figured it out. Beautiful job!

Workshop: Multicolor mix industrial and cement. Absolutely loved it. One of the nicer products I saw today.

Mirage –

Hub: Nine colors, three thicknesses, nine sizes and four surfaces. Lots of SKU's but very nice.

Noon: Wood look with a very nice texture and visual.

Cross Over: Metal line, a nice look.

Murales: Very nice old world industrial concrete. Four colors and the ice is very nice.

Gioia: Porcelain ledger done with inkjet. Very nice.

Serenissima-

Magistra: Five colors in a stone marble graphic. I loved this at Coverings and I think one of the front runners here at Cersaie. Paonazetto color (aka white is awesome.)

Del Conca –

Boutique: Another marble so take your pick but it's very nice.

Tune: A fabric metal that's very nice.
